### Forms & Attributes – Add Custom Grid Headers for Extended Attributes

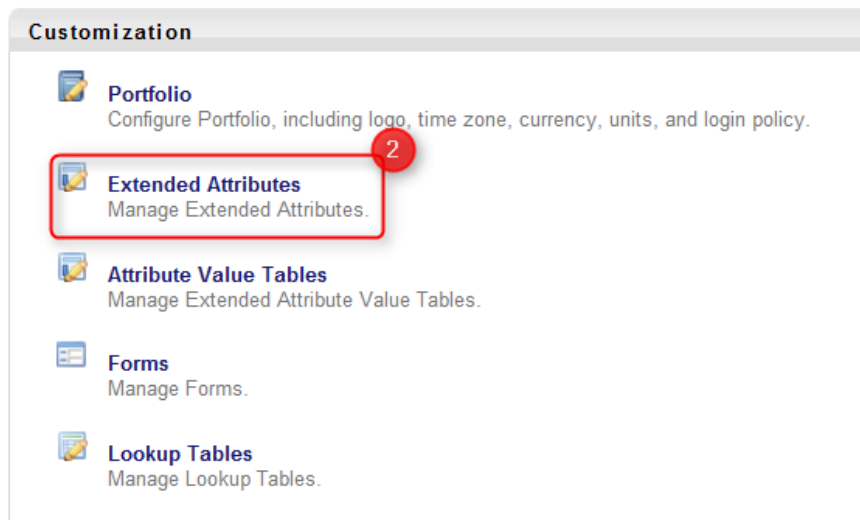
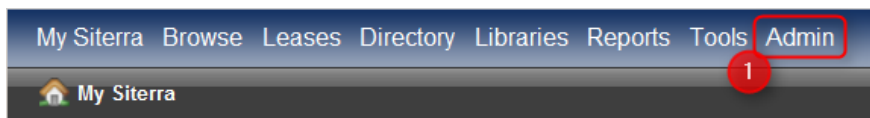
Question:

How are Custom Grid Headers created for an Extended Attribute?

Answer:






Attributes can sometimes have very confusing and long names, which might be required for a specific naming structure. To make grids within Siterra more readable, a Custom Grid Header can replace the column name for this attribute.

To add the Custom Grid Header, click the “Admin” button at the top of the page (1) and then click the “Extended Attributes” on the left (2).



Choose the category the EA is in (1), then find the EA to have a Custom Grid Header applied to. Once located, click the blue and white menu button to the left (2) and select "Edit" (3).
